The MotherCare family would like to warmly welcome all the new children and their families to the kindergarten. The children have been involved in various activities during August. The senior group has been working on classification of the animal kingdom. The other groups have been working on numbers and letters along with various art and crafts according to the season and theme.

A small reminder would be to make sure that your child has enough drinking water during the hot summer days and clothing appropriate for the heat. Cotton clothes would be more appreciated to avoid rashes and excess perspiration. We encourage all the children to take sips of water throughout the day so a small bottle may not be enough. Kindly remember to pack an extra set of clothes clearly labelled with your child's name. Please also note that children should not be sent with precious jewellery. If there is a religious purpose for the item the child has to wear, please kindly inform the teachers. However the school will not be responsible for loss of such items.

Now that September is here bringing along the festive mood starting with Janmastami and Teej followed by Dashain. We will also be starting the Dashain Drive for the children at Orchid Garden Nepal soon. We believe Dashain is a cultural experience for our children as well as a time to share and care so we would like to request you to donate old toys, clothes and any other items to help make this contribution more substantial. We will be putting out a box for the drive and would like to thank you in advance for your generosity.

We in MotherCare believe in encouraging healthy eating habits and hygiene from the very beginning. It has come to our notice that some children are bringing junk food for snacks, we would like to request parents to stop sending unhealthy snacks to school and also ensure that the childrens water bottles are clean.

As we all are aware of the dengue outbreak in Kathmandu, we request the parents to kindly send the children in full sleeves shirt and trousers to school. Also apply mosquito repellent cream and patches for their safety. The school is taking necessary precautions to safeguard the children and school staff from dengue virus.
